

Educational Access Requirements

In order to gain entry onto a EWF/IIW Welding Coordinator Diploma course, candidates must be able to demonstrate that they meet the educational qualification requirements. Details of these requirements (for each level) are outlined below.

SPECIALIST
A National Certificate OR Level 3 NQF/QCF OR an Level 4 EQF, in an engineering science discipline
A Level 3 qualification in Fabrication and Welding Technology
Registered with the UK Engineering Council as an Engineering Technician (EngTech) or above
Successfully complete the Appendix 'Zero (0)' Route (Diploma in Welding pre-assessment)

TECHNOLOGIST
A HNC (or above) in an engineering science discipline
A Level 4 NQF/QCF vocational qualification OR Level 5 EQF in an engineering science discipline
Registered with the UK Engineering Council as an Incorporated Engineer (IEng) or above

ENGINEER
A university degree/Level 6 FHEQ OR a Level 6 NQF/QCF vocational qualification OR Level 6 EQF, in an engineering science discipline
A Level 7 FHEQ OR a Level 7 NQF/QCF OR Level 7 EQF, in an engineering science discipline
A Level 5 NVQ OR Diploma, in an engineering science discipline
A HNC/HND/Level 4 NVQ/Foundation degree in an engineering science discipline AND registered with the UK Engineering Council as an Incorporated Engineer (IEng)
Registered with the UK Engineering Council as a Chartered Engineer (CEng)
